**M** can continue for a long time

**E** *Relying only on fossil fuels is not **sustainable** as they harm the health of our planet.*

#### 2. toll (n) 破壞

**M** a heavy burden on

**E** *Losing the battle is a huge **toll** on the war effort.*

#### 3. exploit (v) 剝削

**M** use in a way that benefits you

**E** *Some online retailers **exploit** their workers.*

#### 4. ethical (adj) 道德的

**M** morally right

**E** *Our **ethical** business practice includes not having shark fin soup from the menu.*

#### 5. living wage (n phr) 夠維持基本生活的工資

**M** work payment that is enough to live on

**E** *The purpose of a minimum wage is to give everyone at least a **living wage**.*

6. **organic** (adj) 有機的

**M** without artificial chemicals

**E** ***Organic** vegetables are usually more expensive.*

7. **synthetic** (adj) 人造的

**M** not made in nature

**E** *Plastic is a **synthetic** material.*

8. **distribute** (v) 分發

**M** give out to others

**E** *The team head **distributed** the red packets.*

9. **dominant** (adj) 主導的

**M** with the biggest influence

**E** *That chimpanzee is the **dominant** male of the group.*

10. **hide** (n) 皮革

**M** animal skin

**E** *Animal **hide** needs to be treated before it can be used.*
