1. **complain (v)** 投訴

M say negative things about something

E *The restaurant customer **complained** about the food being mouldy.*

2. **hallmark (n)** 特徵

M a special feature

E *The many skyscrapers are a **hallmark** of New York.*

3. **trait (n)** 特點

M characteristic

E *One of the **traits** of snails is their slowness.*

4. **pastime (n)** 消遣

M an action to pass the time

E *The boy's favourite **pastime** is baseball.*

5. **gratitude (n)** 感激之情

M the feeling of being thankful

E *The headmistress expressed **gratitude** for the billionaire's generous donation.*

6. entail (v) 牽涉

M involve something

E A restaurant's menu **entails** a lot of brainstorming between the owner and the head chef.

7. appreciation (n) 感謝

M the feeling of being positive about something

E The children all said many words of **appreciation** on Mother's Day.

8. consistently (adv) 不斷地

M again and again

E The athlete has **consistently** won many medals at the Olympics.

9. resilient (adj) 有復原力的

M able to recover quickly

E The politician is so **resilient** that he weathered all scandals.

10. worthiness (n) 值得支持的價值

M being deserving of something

E The naysayers questioned the **worthiness** of the winner of the latest Nobel Peace Prize.
