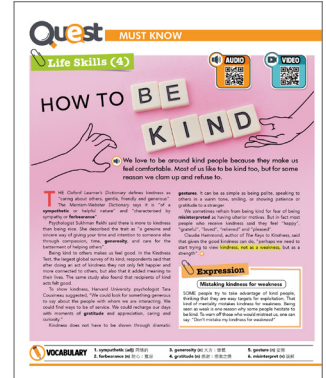




VOCABULARY

Vocabulary from **How to be kind**



M Meaning **E** Example

1. sympathetic (adj) 同情的

M Feeling kind towards someone

E *The boy **felt** sympathetic towards his injured classmate.*

2. forbearance (n) 耐心；寬容

M Having patience

E *The girl has the **forbearance** to volunteer at a soup kitchen for long hours.*

3. generosity (n) 大方；慷慨

M Willing to give money or help for free

E *The donor's **generosity** will not be forgotten.*

4. gratitude (n) 感謝；感激之情

M Thankfulness

E *The beggar felt a lot of **gratitude** to the person who gave him a good meal.*

5. appreciation (n) 欣賞

M Recognition of or understanding that something is valuable

E *The student showed her **appreciation** for receiving a scholarship by getting straight A's.*

M Meaning **E** Example

6. dramatic (adj) 戲劇性的

M Sudden and showy

E *Events took a **dramatic** turn.*

7. gesture (n) 姿態；示意動作

M An action showing a certain meaning

E *The students gave flowers to their teacher as a **gesture** to show they were grateful for her help.*

8. refrain (v) 避免

M To not do something

E *The boy **refrained** from playing videogames to finish his homework first.*

9. misinterpret (v) 誤解

M Incorrect understanding

E *Due to the language barrier, the question was **misinterpreted**.*

10. ulterior motive (n phr) 不可告人的動機

M Another reason behind what is stated

E *John's **ulterior motive** for giving a present was to make the girl tell more secrets.*
